PASTOR'S LETTER

I am very grateful to all who made our celebration of Holy Week such a prayerful and meaningful celebration. May God bless all our extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, lectors, ushers, altar servers, musicians, choirs, and those who so beautifully decorated the churches for Easter.
