Brothers and Sisters,

Thank you for your prayers this past weekend for our trip to Steubenville, OH. It was a grace-filled weekend to spend time with St. Joseph's, St. Patrick's, and St. Philip's groups. Here are some comments from our group:

"Going to Steubenville Youth Conference I had no expectations. I thought it was going to be boring, and I thought 'how are these people going to help me with my faith?' I was mistaken. The Conference was so much fun and eye-opening. I never thought I would ever say church was fun, but it was fun. I now look forward to Mass and just experiencing the Holy Spirit that it offers. Before I went to the Conference, God and I had a rocky relationship. I wasn't letting Him reveal Himself to me. I promise that the people at Steubenville will welcome anyone who wants to build a relationship with the Holy Spirit."

Community Town Hall Conversations about Alzheimer Disease - August 7, 10 am -12 noon at St. Patrick's Parish Hall. More than 23,000 Rhode Islanders are living with Alzheimer's disease, and over 53,000 family and friends are providing them care and support. With the aging of our population this number is expected to climb in the next few years. In response, 5 years ago Rhode Island developed its first state Alzheimer plan, now being updated—and we need to hear from the community. Kicking off on August 5 and concluding August 10, 18 community town meetings are scheduled to allow Rhode Islanders to give their thoughts as to what should be included in the updated State Alzheimer's Plan.

Anyone with an interest is welcome—persons living with dementia, family and professional caregivers, health and long-term care workers, curious citizens.

Our parish community is supporting this effort by hosting one of these community town hall style conversations August 7, from 10 am -12 noon in St. Patrick's Parish Hall.
