Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



If you are not familiar with the First Saturday Devotions, given to Sister Lucy by Our Lady of Fatima, here is a brief description of the miraculous vision Sister Lucy received by the Child Jesus and the Blessed Virgin Mary:

On the evening of Thursday, December 10, 1925, after supper, Sister Lucy dos Santos (then a postulant in the Dorothean house at Pontevedra, Spain) received a visit by the Child Jesus and the Virgin Mary in her convent cell. Showing the young nun a heart surrounded by thorns, Our Lady said to her:

"See, My daughter, My heart surrounded by thorns which ungrateful men pierce at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude... Say to all those who, for five months, on the first Saturday, confess, receive Holy Communion, recite the Rosary and keep Me company for 15 minutes while meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary, in a spirit of reparation, I promise to assist them at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for the salvation of their souls."

This message has touched many hearts and lives. Sister Lucy received many graces of courage to make known the request of our Lady of Fatima. The First Saturday Devotions help us enter deeper into prayer. This prayer we make stands before the Lord and the Virgin Mary to console their hearts from the offenses that humanity commits against them. Let us gather together in prayer to console the Two Hearts. If you feel called to participate but are unable to join us in prayer, consider following these steps in preparation for the First Saturday devotion:

1. Go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation
2. Attend Mass and receive Holy Communion
3. Recite the Rosary
4. Meditate on the mysteries of the Rosary with a spirit of reparation for the sins committed against the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

As the pastor of Saint Joseph and Saint Patrick, I consecrated and entrusted all the families of both

communities to the Sacred Heart of Jesus (2018-2019) and to the Immaculate Heart of Mary (2019-2020). Let us continue to renew our commitment as followers of Christ. Let us persevere in prayer. Let us offer up prayers of thanksgiving for what God has done for us through His Son. Let us better work not to offend our Lord and our Blessed Mother by our actions, thoughts or words. May we trust in the Mercy of God, through His Son, Jesus Christ, who lives for ever and ever. Amen.



sisters and brothers to each other.


We ask for your help in calling on
