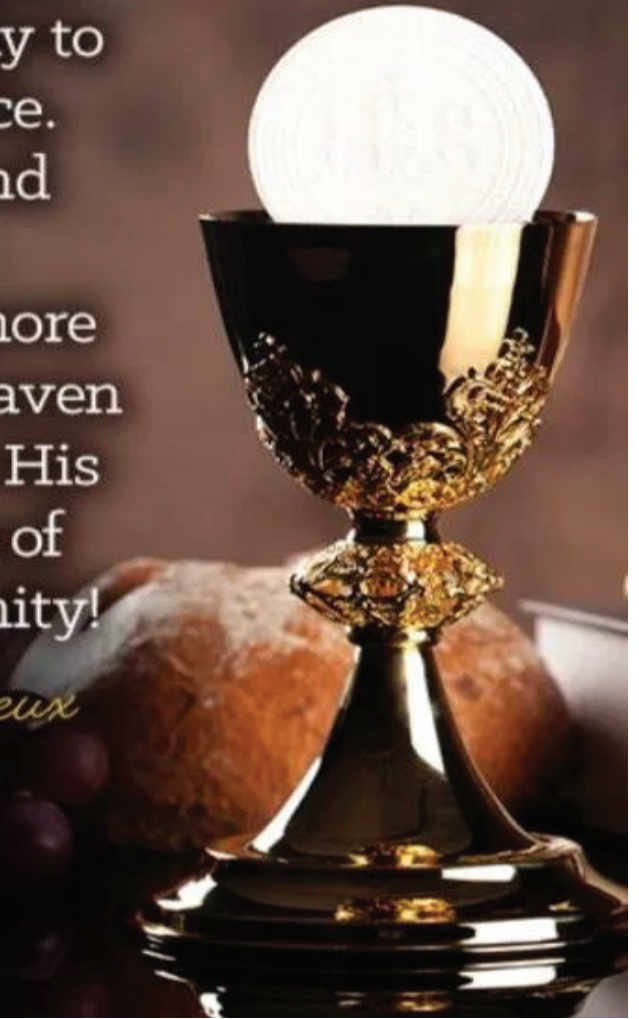

PASTOR'S PAGE



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate the great Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, let us deeply reflect on this miracle that has been given to us by Christ at the Last Supper. Today, let us continue to see that this miracle is revealed when we participate at the celebration of the Mass.

God is with us. He promised to be with us always until the end of the age. Here, in the miracle of the Eucharist, when the bread and wine are transformed, in substance, into the Body and Blood of Christ, Jesus Christ is present with us and among us. The big Catholic word that is used to describe this moment is Transubstantiation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states in paragraph 1374: *"The mode of Christ's presence under the Eucharistic species is unique. It raises the Eucharist above all the sacraments as 'the perfection of the spiritual life and the end to which all the sacraments tend.' In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist 'the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained...' 'This present is called 'real' ...but because it is presence in the fullest sense: that is to say, it is a substantial presence by which Christ, God and man, makes himself wholly and entirely present."*

The Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. Many lives, mine included, have been transformed by the Eucharistic Presence of our Lord. All our devotions and prayers especially at the celebration of the Mass points to and leads us to Christ. May the Holy Spirit, fill us with a new grace of devotion and dedication to Christ truly present in the Blessed Sacrament.

In today's Gospel, Jesus teaches all of us about the Eucharist. "Jesus said to them, 'Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the

Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him.'" (John 6:53-56)

Jesus reveals having eternal life when we eat His flesh and drink His Blood. A biblical scholar reflects on the Book of Exodus, in the Old Testament, when God gives manna (bread) from Heaven to feed His people when they left Egypt. Making the connection for today's Solemnity, this biblical scholar explains how Jesus is the true Bread from Heaven, because He comes from Heaven (Word become flesh) and gives us the Eucharistic miracle for us to encounter the true God and have true food that prepares us for eternal life.
