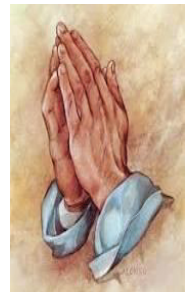

and to build a just society.

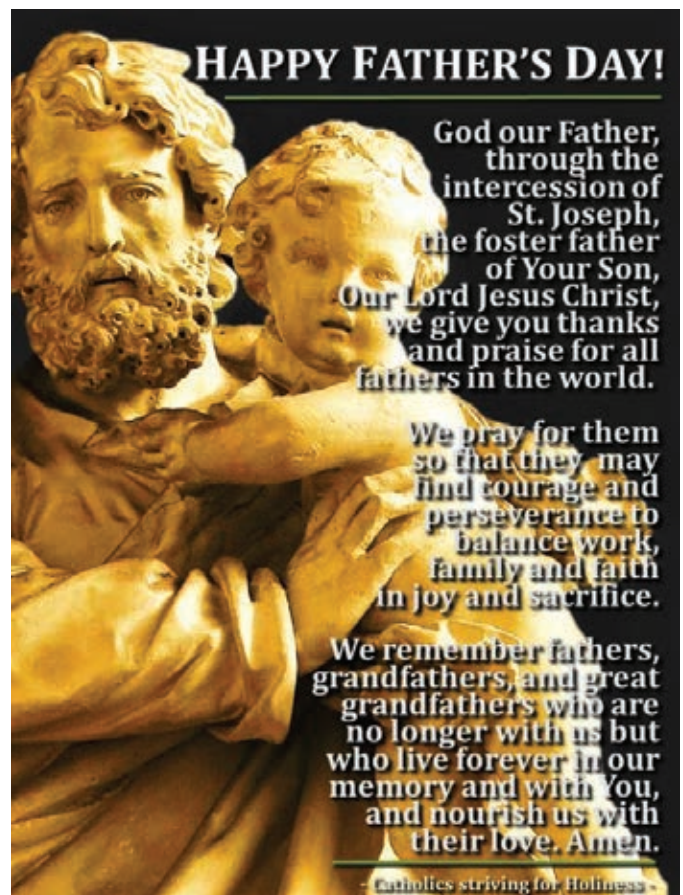
We ask for your help in following your Son,
