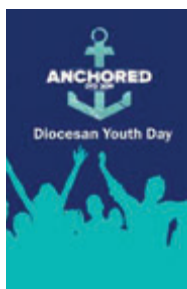


**PILGRIMAGE TO MEXICO; OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE** –
